SHOEBOX PROJECT









The Shoebox Project is a new annual initiative by **Sunway Student Volunteers (SSV)**, evolving from its origins as Shoebox Christmas. Initially focused on delivering educational gifts to children in underprivileged communities, the project now aims to create a more enduring impact for its beneficiaries starting this year.

The initiative aims to deliver educational workshops and gifts to children from B40 families, refugee backgrounds, and disadvantaged households. Additionally, a fundraising campaign is being launched to provide indigenous communities with water filters, underscoring the essential role of clean water in promoting health. This project is dedicated to raising awareness of social issues, using festive celebrations as a meaningful platform to express support and care through impactful gifts.



This year, SGT embraced SSA's mission of 3T Contributions - Time, Talent, and Treasure - toward community support.

With 42 corporate sponsors and NGO partners championing the cause, the event saw:

- Time: 2,000 hours contributed by the organising committee
- Talent: 100 talented students submitting applications
- Treasure: RM15,000 raised through sponsorships

Sunway Meal Pack-A-Thon 2024











In celebration of Sunway's 50th anniversary, over 1,000 volunteers were needed to help achieve the goal of packing more than 2 million meals in Southeast Asia's largest one-day meal pack-a-thon.

On 4th September 2024, alongside Sunway Group's partner, Rise Against Hunger Malaysia, 60 volunteers from SSV contributed by packing rice, soy, dried vegetables, and 23 essential vitamins and nutrients for those facing undernourishment.











In conjunction with #CampusWithAConscience (CWAC) week, SSV hosted Health Week 2024, a collaboration with various healthcare organisations, including Sunway Eye Care Center, National Cancer Society Malaysia, Pusat Darah Negara, Association of Hypnotherapy Practitioners Malaysia and more!

The event featured health check-ups to support Sunway students and staff in gaining valuable health insights and fostering awareness of their own well-being.


